Chaining begins with words or syllable contexts the child can produce. This one is for children who can produce /k/ word finally but not word initially. Start with 'make, 'work', etc. Build up to the child saying 'making', 'working' etc. Exaggerate the second syllable: 'making', 'working' etc. and then move to 'making-king', 'working-king' etc., and ultimately many repetitions of the word 'king' before moving on to /k/ SIWI in CVs and CVCs.
